At the beginning of the meeting, Dr. R. Tamilmaran, Member Secretary, welcomed the chairperson and the members of the committee. Dr.M.G. Sethuraman, External Member could not attend the Meeting due to some urgent work. He then invited the Chairperson of the CIQA Committee, Prof. S. Arumugam, Vice-Chancellor of TNOU, to give his opening remarks.

The Vice-Chancellor cum Chairperson, CIQA welcomed all the newly joined members of the CIQA Committee. He elaborated on the upcoming events and initiatives planned to enhance the quality of the University. Prof. S. Arumugam commended the outstanding contributions of the CIQA Team, including Dr. R. Tamilmaran, Director of CIQA, Dr. R. Meenambigai, and Dr. E. Kumar, Deputy Directors of CIQA. He acknowledged the dedicated efforts of the CIQA team in improving the quality of university-related activities, implementing new strategies, and providing valuable guidance to ensure the University's activities maintain the highest standards. Dr.E.Kumar attended the meeting as a special invitee to the meeting.

Additionally, the Vice-Chancellor highlighted that NIRF has recently unveiled a ranking process for Open Universities. TNOU has submitted detailed data concerning their academic programs, faculty, research publications, and other relevant metrics. The CIQA Team and the NIRF facilitators diligently worked to ensure that TNOU meets the criteria required for this ranking, demonstrating their commitment to continuous improvement and excellence.

The committee congratulated the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor and the entire team for achieving this prestigious recognition in the NAAC accreditation process.

	The Chairperson of the Committee noted that the Peer Team members, in their recommendations, had duly recognized TNOU's status. The CIQA Team has prepared a strategic action plan, incorporating recommendations from the Peer Team report. This plan, upon review and approval by the statutory bodies, will be implemented in the future to enhance the University's quality and performance.

Resolution	The committee was informed that the university has carried out the process of submitting online applications for the recognition of ODL programs to UGC-DEB, starting from the academic session commencing in July-August 2023

Resolution	 The committee was informed that Administration Division initiated the process for the promotion of teachers under Career Advancement Scheme by inviting applications from the eligible teachers at the university. 1. The applications were invited from eligible teachers on 11th September 2023 by the Administrative Division for promotion or different levels. 2. Due to administrative reasons, the last date for submission or application was extended up to 31-10-2023. The University Grants Commission (Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and other Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education) Regulations, 2018 and G.O 5 are considering for promotion of teachers. However, no process has been initiated in this regard. In this meeting, it was stressed that the CAS process for teachers should be resumed as per University Grants Commission (Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic staff in Universities and Colleges and other Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education, (4th Amendment) Regulations, 2024 for extending the time period up to 31st December 2024 to exercise the option to follow either UGC Regulations, 2010 or 2018 for CAS promotion, notified and published in the Gazette Notification of UGC on 20th June 2024. Resolution	National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) provides a framework for ranking Higher Education Institutions in India. While traditionally focused on Universities, NIRF has extended its evaluation criteria to include Open Universities from 2023-24 onwards. This initiative aims to assess and rank Open Universities based on various parameters, fostering transparency and promoting excellence in the Indian Higher Education System. In compliance with the directive from the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, the CIQA team is designated to look after the NIRF procedures for TNOU, along with managing responsibilities related to UGC-DEB affairs and AICTE-approved initiatives. Hence, the NIRF for TNOU has been registered on 13-01-2024. Simultaneously, the CIQA Team is responsible for the mandatory submission of the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) for the year 2023-24. The NIRF ranking will be reflecting the status and ranking the Open University in India every year. The NIRF data was submitted in the portal on 08-03-2024 successfully. TNOU is awaiting the result.
